Call Meeting to Order 2:04PM (review attendance by roll call)

Approve Agenda

- *Call for additions to the agenda. No additions.*
- *John Falck moves to approve the agenda as posted. Erica Harris seconds. All in favor. No abstentions or objections. Agenda as posted approved.*
- *During Presentation about the field usage request, Rosalynn asked whether we need to be more clear about how many camps are interested in using the field. Motion to amend the agenda language "from camp to camps, adding the "s". Vote details below.*

- *No public comments*

Presentation by Mr. Graves about Usage Requests

- *This proposal is consistent with intended rental usage previously discussed with the community: daytime hours, summer week days, for youth athletic camps.*
- *The initial vendor usage request was withdrawn, but there are similar rental proposals to consider.*

LSC Member Questions (in sequence)

- *To be on the safe side, could we amend the agenda to read "camps" instead of "camp"? Vote to approve edit of motion to state "camps", rather than "camp".*
- *Question raised as to how we can encourage safe parking out of respect for the neighboring community. ANSWER: Proposal reflects request to limit parking. Could allow parking in the teacher lot.*



- *Who monitors social distancing compliance? ANSWER: CPS requests adherence to policy for social distancing. Vendor is responsible for compliance with policy. We are not responsible for monitoring or enforcing compliance with social distancing.*
- *Suggestion: Ask each camp to offer 3 spots / discounts / scholarships to LaSalle students. Included this request to interested vendors.*
- *Question about eating and snacks. Proposal language notes that vendors are responsible for not snacking and leaving trash on the turf field.*

- No building access will be granted, nor access to playground (per CPS due to COVID)
- Social distancing guidelines set by the City of Chicago will be followed
- Camps are open to non-LaSalle students and LaSalle students
- Recommend to camps that they add language about nearby parking options (including school staff parking lot)
- Mr. Graves will ask each camp if they will offer free spots / scholarships / discounts to LaSalle students
- Each camp will be asked to clean up / leave the facilities as they found them
